CONSUMER REPORT AUTHORIZATION FOR A BACKGROUND INVESTIGATION

I understand that I have the right, under the "Fair Credit Reporting Act," to request additional information on the nature and scope of the consumer report from the CRA providing the report to the Company, by writing to the CRA directly. I understand that I may request the name and address of the CRA from the Company.

Under Section 1786.22 of the California Civil Code, you have the right to request from the Consumer Reporting Agency identified above, upon proper identification, the nature and substance of all information in its files on you, including the sources of information, and the recipients of any reports on you, which the Consumer Reporting Agency has previously furnished within the two-year period preceding your request. You may view the file maintained on you by the named Consumer Reporting Agency during normal business hours. You may also obtain a copy of this file upon submitting proper identification and paying the costs of duplication services. Upon making a written request, you may receive a summary of your report via telephone.

Under Section 1786.16(a)(2)(B)(vi) of the California Civil Code, you are notified that Accurate Background's privacy practices can be found at www.accuratebackground.com

Under Section 1785.20.5 of the California Civil Code and Section 1024.5 of the California Labor Code, you are notified that a credit report may be ordered if you are applying for a position involving access to confidential or proprietary information.

Notice to MAINE Applicants

Under Chapter 210 Section 1314 of Maine Revised Statutes, you have the right, upon request, to be informed within 5 business days of such request of whether or not an investigative consumer report was requested. Under Article 25 Section 380-g of the New York General Business Law, should a consumer report received by an employer contain criminal conviction information, the employer must provide to the applicant or employee who is the subject of the report, a printed or electronic copy of Article 23-A of the New York Correction Law, which governs the employment of persons previously convicted of one or more criminal offenses.
